WARNING: Risk of electrical shock. High temperatures inside luminaire. Make certain line voltage corrresponds with ballast's primary voltage. (See ballast label)


WARNING: All wiring to be performed per National Electrical Code and local code by a qualified electrician.


WARNING: Make sure lamps are properly seated and oriented in sockets before energizing the circuit.


Fixtures may become damaged by improper lamp installation voiding warranty.




